Our Refugee Claimant Employment services program has delivered impactful initiatives aimed at supporting newcomers and refugees in their journey toward meaningful employment.

Employment & Skill Development Workshops:

In the skill development workshops, we empowered 25 participants with practical tools for career advancement. Batch 1 included 10 participants, while Batch 2 expanded to 15 participants, reflecting the growing demand for these services. Each session was 2 hours for 12 sessions.

English Classes: We conducted two successful batches, each accommodating 20 participants. These sessions provided essential language skills to help participants integrate effectively into the workforce and the community. These structured English Classes were held twice a week for 6 weeks for 2 hours each.

The Hiring Event was held by Refugee serving organizations and HMF was one of the sponsors. The hiring event connected refugees with employment opportunities, resulting in significant outcomes:

- 5 clients from HMF who were short listed to attend
- 2 job offers were extended to 2 attendees from HMF
- 2 candidates progressing to second-round interviews
- 1 candidate received constructive feedback for future improvement

Employment Services: Our team assisted over 50 individuals in crafting professional resumes and cover letters tailored to the Canadian job market. This service has been instrumental in increasing participants' confidence and readiness for job applications.
