

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please review the agreement and requirements below and confirm your understanding of these requirements and regulations.

ENTRY AGREEMENT

Artists must read, understand, and agree to the following terms of the Entry Agreement:

- All works selected will be displayed at the art exhibition.
- If any artist would like to put up their artwork for sale at the art exhibition to be announced soon, then details can be discussed.
- Please ensure that you have read all the “Terms and Conditions” before proceeding.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

By entering the HMF Art Competition 2026 organized by Healthy Muslim Families, participants agree to adhere to the following entry conditions:

1. Eligibility:

The Competition is open to artists Canada-wide, regardless of age and ethnicity.

2. Submission Requirements:

- The artwork you submit should strictly follow Islamic guidelines in line with the theme for this year, which is ***“Calligraphy: The Art and Legacy of Islamic Calligraphy”***
- Participants may submit as many quality original artworks in any visual art medium as they want.
- Artworks can be previously exhibited, published, or awarded.
- Submissions must not infringe upon the rights of any third party, including copyright, trademark, or privacy rights.
- Each artwork submission must accompany a brief description (up to 150 words) explaining the artistic concept and inspiration.
- Participating artists are solely responsible for the cost of shipping their artwork to and from the office.
- Healthy Muslim Families will ensure proper care and handling of the artwork. Artists must ensure that their artwork is securely and professionally packaged to prevent any damage during transit.

- The organizers will not be held liable for any loss, delay, or damage that occurs due to insufficient or improper packaging.
- Artists must include a prepaid, pre-addressed return shipping label with their submission or make independent arrangements for the collection of their artwork after the event.
- Artworks left unclaimed after 30 days of the exhibition may be considered abandoned and disposed of at the discretion of the organizers.
- All submissions must be received by **September 30, 2026, before 11:59 PM.**

3. Theme:

Artworks should reflect the theme of “Calligraphy: The Art and Legacy of Islamic Calligraphy”. Participants are encouraged to explore concepts of architecture, Islamic symbolism, and philosophy in their submissions.

4. Entry Fee:

There is no Entry Fee to enter this competition.

5. Submission Process:

Participants must read the terms and conditions and complete the registration forms accompanied by their artwork files with accurate and up-to-date contact information.

6. Ownership and Copyright:

- Participants retain full copyright and ownership of their submitted artworks.
- By entering the Competition, participants grant Healthy Muslim Families the right to use and display the submitted artworks for promotional and exhibition purposes, including, but not limited to, press releases, social media, and marketing materials.

7. Judging and Selection:

- Submissions will be judged based on creativity, originality, technical skill, concept, and adherence to the theme.
- The judging panel will consist of qualified individuals selected by Healthy Muslim Families.
- The panel's decisions are final and binding in all matters related to the HMF Art Competition 2026.

8. Prizes:

- First Place: C\$300
- Second Place: C\$200

- Third Place: C\$100

9. Gallery Display:

The Organizers will be responsible for curating and installing the exhibition at the venue, which will be announced soon.

10. Publicity and Promotion:

Participants agree to use their names, artworks, descriptions, and biographical information for promotional and publicity purposes related to the HMF Art Competition 2026 venue, which will be announced soon.

11. Important Dates to Note:

Submission Deadline: **Wednesday, September 30th, 2026, before 11:59 PM**

Winners Announcement: **Third Week of October - Tentative**

Gallery Exhibition: To be announced soon.

12. Disqualification:

- Healthy Muslim Families reserves the right to disqualify any submission that violates copyright, contains offensive or inappropriate content, or fails to comply with these entry conditions.
- By submitting an entry to the Competition, participants acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to abide by these entry conditions. The Organizer reserves the right to modify, extend, or cancel the Competition for any reason.
